Want to join family or extend your stay in the UK? Applying for settlement or citizenship?

Then you can take a LanguageCert SELT for Life in the UK exam to prove your Speaking & Listening skills in English. The level required depends on your exact visa type.

Which exam do I need to take?

Each visa application has a specific English language requirement set by the UK Home Office. Below you can find which LanguageCert SELT exam corresponds to the visa type you are applying for.
